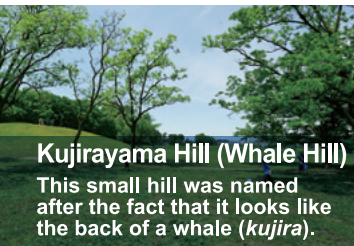




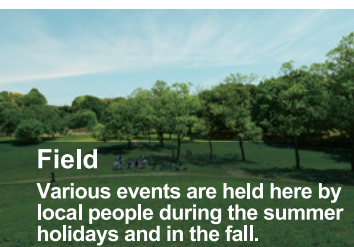
Nursery

Hake no Michi Path: "Not even many of the local people know that this path is called 'Hake.'" This is a quote from *Musashino Fujin*, a book by the novelist Shohei Ooka. Also mentioned in this book are the Kokubunji Cliff Line and Nogawa River. The use of the word "Musashino" to describe this whole area in works like Doppo Kunikida's masterpiece *Musashino* has a unique atmosphere and effect. Musashino Park preserves a piece of the past in this way.

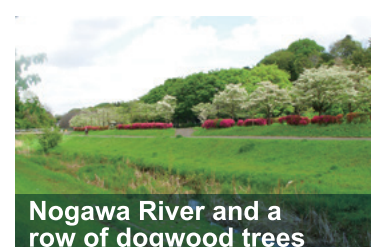
Cherry blossoms

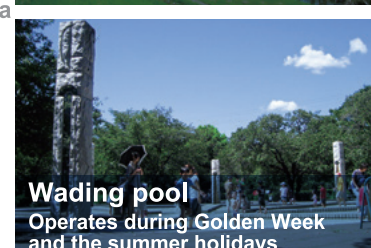


Autumn leaves of Japanese maple

Late November to early December

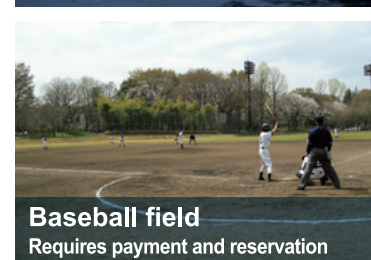


Nogawa River and a row of dogwood trees



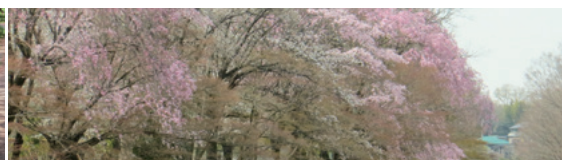
Wading pool
